HAZARD STATEMENTS:

Extremely flammable gas
May displace oxygen and cause rapid suffocation.
May cause genetic defects.
May cause cancer.
May damage fertility or the unborn child.
Toxic if inhaled.
Causes skin irritation.
Causes serious eye irritation.
Causes central nervous system depression, respiratory irritation drowsiness or dizziness and damage to lungs, liver and blood cells.
Causes damage to the heart through prolonged or repeated exposures.
Causes damage to blood forming tissues and central nervous system through prolonged or repeated exposure.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Keep away from heat/sparks/open flames/hot surfaces – No smoking.
Leaking gas fire: Do not extinguish, unless leak can be stopped safely.
Eliminate all ignition sources if safe to do so.
Store in well-ventilated place.
Keep container tightly closed.
Do not breathe gas.
Use only outdoors or in a well-ventilated area.
Wear protective gloves / protective clothing / eye protection / face protection.
Wash thoroughly after handling.
Obtain special instructions before use.
Do not handle until all safety precautions have been read and understood.
Do not eat, drink or smoke when using this product.
If exposed, concerned or feel unwell: Get medical advice/attention.
If in eyes: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue Rinsing. If eye irritation persists:
Get medical advice/attention.
If on skin: Take off contaminated clothing and wash it before reuse. Wash with plenty of water. If skin irritation occurs: get medical advice/attention.
If inhaled: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. Call a poison center or doctor
Store locked up.
Dispose of contents in accordance with federal, state and local regulations.
