Every year, slips, trips and falls top the list of preventable injuries, especially in colder months. Here are a few things you can do to reduce your risks and keep you and your family safe:

• Wear proper footwear: Wear slip-resistant shoes with good tread or invest in overshoes for high-risk situations. Remove snow or water from footwear when entering buildings to reduce indoor slipping hazards




