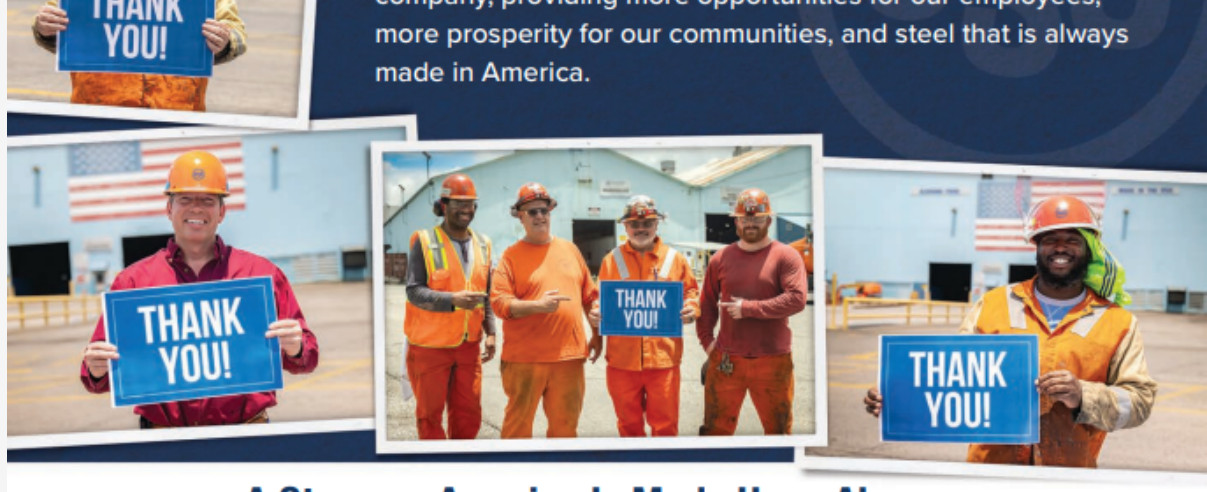

## ENVIRONMENTAL EXCELLENCE



U. S. Steel's Mon Valley Works won a Pennsylvania Governor's Award for Environmental Excellence for the second consecutive year by prioritizing the use of innovative recycling technology.

**Why it matters:** This award highlights our commitment to sustainability and continuous improvement in environmental performance.

- Our recycling facility processes 6,000 tons annually, preventing 20 tons of CO2 per ton recycled.
- This equates to removing 26,000 cars from the road and improving air quality.

**The big picture:** The award specifically recognizes the Mon Valley Works Clairton Plant's expanded recycling of coke plant materials project and its partnership with AKJ Steel, a company specializing in managing, processing and recycling materials generated from by-product recovery coke plants. This comprehensive recycling process enhances energy efficiency while protecting employees, equipment, and the environment.

- The cutting-edge approach avoids incineration and minimizes potential air and water contamination risks, with the new facility ensuring coke plant materials can be processed and recycled in the shortest amount of time.

**Flashback:** Last year, Mon Valley Works was honored for its battery-powered locomotive project.

- U.S. Steel's involvement underscores our commitment to community and vital health initiatives.

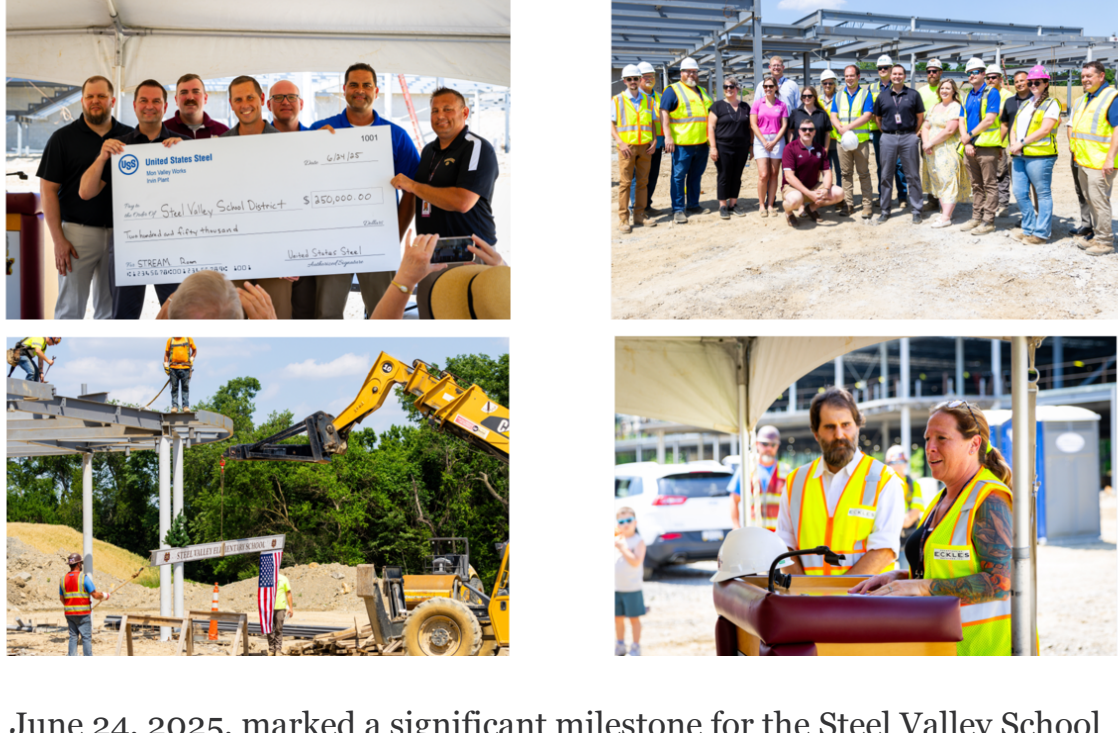
**The event:** A heartfelt ceremony featured participants sharing experiences and expressing gratitude.

June 24, 2025, marked a significant milestone for the Steel Valley School District with the Topping Off Ceremony for a new 128,440-square-foot elementary school.

**Why it matters:** The new state-of-the-art school will feature a STREAM room for Science, Technology, Research, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics.

- U. S. Steel contributed \$250,000 for learning materials, fostering dynamic educational experiences.

**Community impact:** The new facility will unite two current elementary schools into one, bringing all K-12 students onto the same campus.
