



U. S. Steel Mon Valley Works Environmental Policy

U. S. Steel Mon Valley Works is an integrated steel manufacturing facility that is comprised of three manufacturing plants: the Edgar Thomson Plant, located in Braddock along the Monongahela River, the Irvin Plant, located in West Mifflin above the Monongahela River, and the galvanize line at the Fairless Plant, located in Fairless Hills along the Delaware River. At Edgar Thomson, raw materials are converted into high quality steel slabs. These slabs are subsequently converted into high quality steel sheet at the Irvin Plant. At the Fairless Plant, steel sheet is galvanized. The Mon Valley Works produces world-class steel sheet that is used in demanding manufacturing applications such as the automotive industry, appliance industry and metal building industry.
