This Monthly Progress Report (Report) is submitted in compliance with Section XV, Paragraph 1 and Attachment II of the above referenced Consent Order. As specified in the Consent Order, progress reports will be submitted monthly. This report includes the period from June 1, 2020 through June 30, 2020. The next report (August 15, 2020) will include the period from July 1, 2020 through July 31, 2020.

A. <u>ACTIVITIES INITIATED, UNDERTAKEN AND COMPLETED</u>

Agency Involvement

- IDEM was onsite to take sediment samples from the Grand Calumet River on June 16.
- The USGS was onsite to conduct routine monitoring on June 17.

• Public Involvement

 USS received a citizen complaint on June 9 about elevated water levels in the West Grand Calumet Lagoon (WGCL) and Marquette lagoons. USS evaluated drainage at the discharge culvert at the west end of the WGCL and found debris accumulation from recent storm events. Debris was removed and water elevation subsided to normal levels.

Submitted RCRA monthly May progress report on June 15.

• Facility-Wide RCRA Facility Investigation (RFI)

- Received response and authorization from USEPA on GRW summary report O&M recommendations on June 1.
- Started Priority Area 2 additional site investigation on June 2.

- Completed 2nd quarter ISM groundwater sampling on June 16.
- Completed 2nd quarter HWD-2 groundwater sampling on June 16.

C. <u>DEVIATIONS IN REPLY TO: PLANNED ACTIVITIES MADE DURING</u>

REPORT PERIOD

The evaporative spray system at the CAMU was not started in June as planned. After doing troubleshooting of the system we believe calcium buildup in the leachate collection piping is restricting sufficient leachate from accumulating in the collection sump to support optimal pump operation to the sprays. We are currently looking at mitigation measures to clean out the leachate collection pipe connected to the system. If that option does not work, alternative operations, including pumping supernatant or accessing a different leachate sump will be pursued.
