Steel's Big River Steel Works, in collaboration with the Metal Museum, proudly unveiled a stunning new sculpture in nearby Memphis, Tennessee, at the FedEx Forum, which is home to the NBA's Memphis Grizzlies. Titled The Big River Steel Globe – Steel Shapes Our World and installed at Big River Steel Plaza outside the arena, the globe stands as a tribute to the enduring strength and global impact of steel.

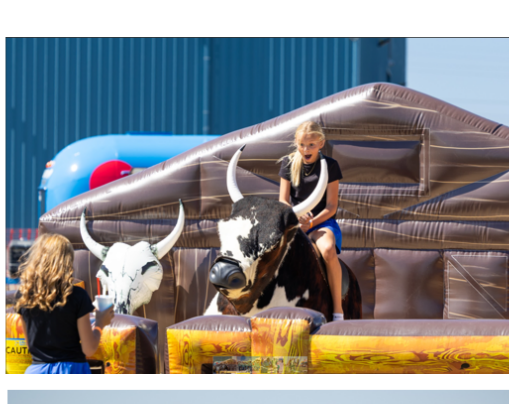
Crafted from steel produced at Big River Steel Works, the sculpture features a dynamic pattern of small coils that expand outward to form a globe as a visual metaphor for how steel connects industries and communities across the world.

Inside the globe, intricate steel cutouts highlight major industries we power through steel, including construction, automotive, and infrastructure, while smaller symbols woven throughout reflect things that are important to U. S. Steel, including sustainability, innovation, and resilience.

The unveiling event brought together leaders from Big River Steel Works, the Metal Museum, the Memphis Grizzlies, and the local community to honor the role of steel in shaping our shared future.

This collaborative work between Big River Steel Works and the Metal Museum is more than a piece of art — it's a celebration of American steelmaking and a reminder that steel is not just about strength, but about possibility, progress, and unity.
