These efforts are part of a larger wave of investments across U. S. Steel, modernizing facilities, strengthening capabilities, and positioning us — and the communities we call home — for the future.



Stay in the kitchen while you are frying, grilling, boiling or broiling food;

Keep anything that can catch fire away from your stovetop.
When using a space heater, remember these five best practices\*:
Keep all flammables, like paper, clothing, bedding, drapes or rugs, at least 3 feet from a space heater, stove or fireplace;
Never leave portable heaters and fireplaces unattended; turn off heaters and make sure fireplace embers are extinguished before

• If you must use a space heater, place it on a level, nonflammable

surface, like ceramic tile, not on a rug or carpet;


